

Prepare for the fair tips



Attending a careers fair can be a daunting prospect, particularly if this is your first event of this type and you have not spoken to many employers in the past. However, a little preparation can really help you to feel less nervous and, of course, to make the most of the event.

Review the list of exhibitors, go through them in detail, and visit their websites to see what they do. Take note of any that interest you and any specific questions you have. Then consider some more general questions that you could ask at the fair. Your questions should help you gather insights about the recruitment process, what it is like to work at the organisation, opportunities, benefits, skills needed etc.

On the day, try to move around the fair independently, visiting the organisations you are interested in. A good tip is to walk around the fair once to get a feel for the event and take note of who you are interested in. Then go round a second time ready to ask your questions.
