#### Web of Science - Arts & Humanities Citation Index

A database within Web of Science, the Arts & Humanities Citation Index lists millions of journal articles. The **Find It** button searches for full text online or checks the catalogue for a print version where available.

More than 300 of the top language & literature journals from start to recent issues (not current parts). Mostly full text but if not, click on the title of the article to find the **Find It** button.
