Iranian-born screenwriter, director and activist, Tina Gharavi, is an award-winning filmmaker who will discuss her work in documentary and drama, followed by a screening of what Sir Ben Kingsley has called 'a life enhancing, important and much needed film'. Gharavi's first feature film, BAFTA-nominated *I am Nasrine* (2012), was shot in England and Iran and is one of the most provocative and raw recent films to document the plight of refugees and the power of protest.
