



Friends of ANCHOR – Summer Research Placement for haematology and oncology-based projects

The Friends of ANCHOR summer research placement scheme provides the opportunity for undergraduate students in science and medicine to carry out a dedicated research project in the fields of haematology or oncology.

Applications are invited from employees of NHS Grampian, University of Aberdeen and Robert Gordon University for funding of a proposed summer research placement project.

A maximum of 4 projects will be funded by Friends of ANCHOR next year, to be completed over summer 2022.

Funding up to a maximum of £3,000 is available.

- Student bursary of £200 per week, up to £2000 (project duration of 6 – 10 weeks)
- Up to £500 for consumable costs
- Up to £500 towards student travel costs for conference abstract presentation

Upon successful application, the applicant must source a suitable student to complete the project and ensure all host institution approvals are in place.
