Challenge: Students felt uncomfortable engaging in freestyle networking, particularly approaching professionals at the start of the event.


Response: Provision of additional support through a lecture on networking skills and a 'networking guide'.

Challenge: A high level of organisation is required to book the room, schedule speakers, attendees and organise catering.


Response: Recruitment of a student networking event team, and sufficient admin support.






