

## Clinical academic pay scales (Scotland) from 1 April 2024

### 1. Summary of changes

The pay scales for medical and dental consultants have been uplifted by 10.5% to basic pay from **1 April 2024**, and the value of all Discretionary Points has been increased from their current level of £3,204 to £3,600 from **1 April 2024**.

The pay scales for doctors and dentists in training have been uplifted by 8.5% to basic pay from **1 April 2024** with an additional uplift of 2.3% from **1 October 2024**.

The values of distinction awards for consultants are unchanged from last year.

### 2. Transitional pay arrangements

The transition period for staff holding honorary consultant contracts who transferred to the 2004 consultant contract under the provisions of paragraphs 14.2.3, 14.2.4, 14.2.6 of the terms and conditions of service for consultant grade staff in Scotland has ended. Table 7 has not therefore been updated.
