# PTEA 2023-2024 Proforma Criteria

1. Case study title
2. Describe the context of your / the project team's approach to enhance teaching and learning.
3. Provide a description of the project and either briefly describe your role as an individual, and if applicable, the role of all other stakeholders involved in the project; or briefly describe the roles of all named above.
4. Give a rationale for your / the project team's teaching approach or new initiative.
5. Provide details of how your / the project team's new teaching approach or solution has been / will be disseminated with colleagues and students within and beyond the University. Is the approach transferable to other disciplines?
6. Identify the key learnings points - what have you / the project team learned from this initiative and how has it further enhanced you / the project team's practice?
7. Explain how you have / the project team has evaluated the impact or influence of your initiative.
