Remit:

In accordance with Supplementary Regulation 15 for the Degree of Master of Arts, Supplementary Regulation 9 for the Degree of BMus (Education), Supplementary Regulation 13 for the PGDE, and Regulation 17 for Degrees in Person-Centred Counselling:

- (i) To consider the cases of MA, PGDE, Person Centred Counselling, Person Centred Counselling: Children and Young People and Counselling Skills students, referred to the Committee by the Head of the School of Education, whose behaviour is considered to be not befitting a student of the School of Education, or whose health gives cause for concern and which, in either case, raises concerns as to their fitness to practise.
- (ii) To make decisions on such cases, on behalf of the Senate, in accordance with the relevant University Guidance Note.
