






## Where to eat and drink

If you hold an offer for a single honours or joint honours for any of the subjects listed below, please attend either the Medical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Engineering or Modern Languages, Translation and Interpretation talk as appropriate. There will be an opportunity to speak with academics giving the talk about your degree subject area. Feel free also to pop into Elphinstone Hall 21 and speak with an academic at the relevant subject stand.

#### **Medical Sciences Talk:**

Biochemistry, Biomedical Sciences, Biotechnology, Exercise & Health Sciences, Genetics, Human Embryology & Developmental Biology, Immunology, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, Neuroscience with Psychology, Pharmacology, Physiology and Sport & Exercise Science.

#### Talk timetable

Spend time learning about the subject for which you hold an offer. Activities vary between degree programmes; some may offer tours of the department, mock lectures or practical demonstrations, as well as giving you the chance to quiz current students.

Some subject talks are repeated while others are only held once but for a longer period of time. If the talk is repeated, they will be identical and you only need to attend one. Some talks also include a tour of labs/facilities at the end and are therefore slightly longer in length. If you hold an offer for a joint degree, you are encouraged to attend the talk for each subject in your offer.







## **Medicine and G2M**

Medicine activities will be taking place at the Suttie Centre (AB25 2ZD) at our Foresterhill campus starting at 1pm. Medicine and Gateway2Medicine students are encouraged to spend the morning on King's campus with campus tours, sports tours, exhibitions and general talks taking place throughout the morning.

Offer holders will experience a day in the life of a medical student with an exciting set of activities that will start promptly at 1pm and run until 4.30pm. This will include several talks and lectures as well as getting to experience GP and anatomy teaching sessions and getting some hands-on experiences in our clinical skills centre. There will also be an hour long information session for parents and carers, which will run several times during the afternoon.

This is a whole afternoon experience so please ensure that you arrive in good time so that you do not miss any activities.






