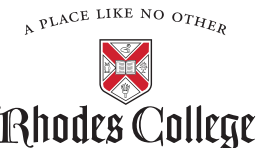
### Admission to Rhodes College

A complete application to Rhodes includes:

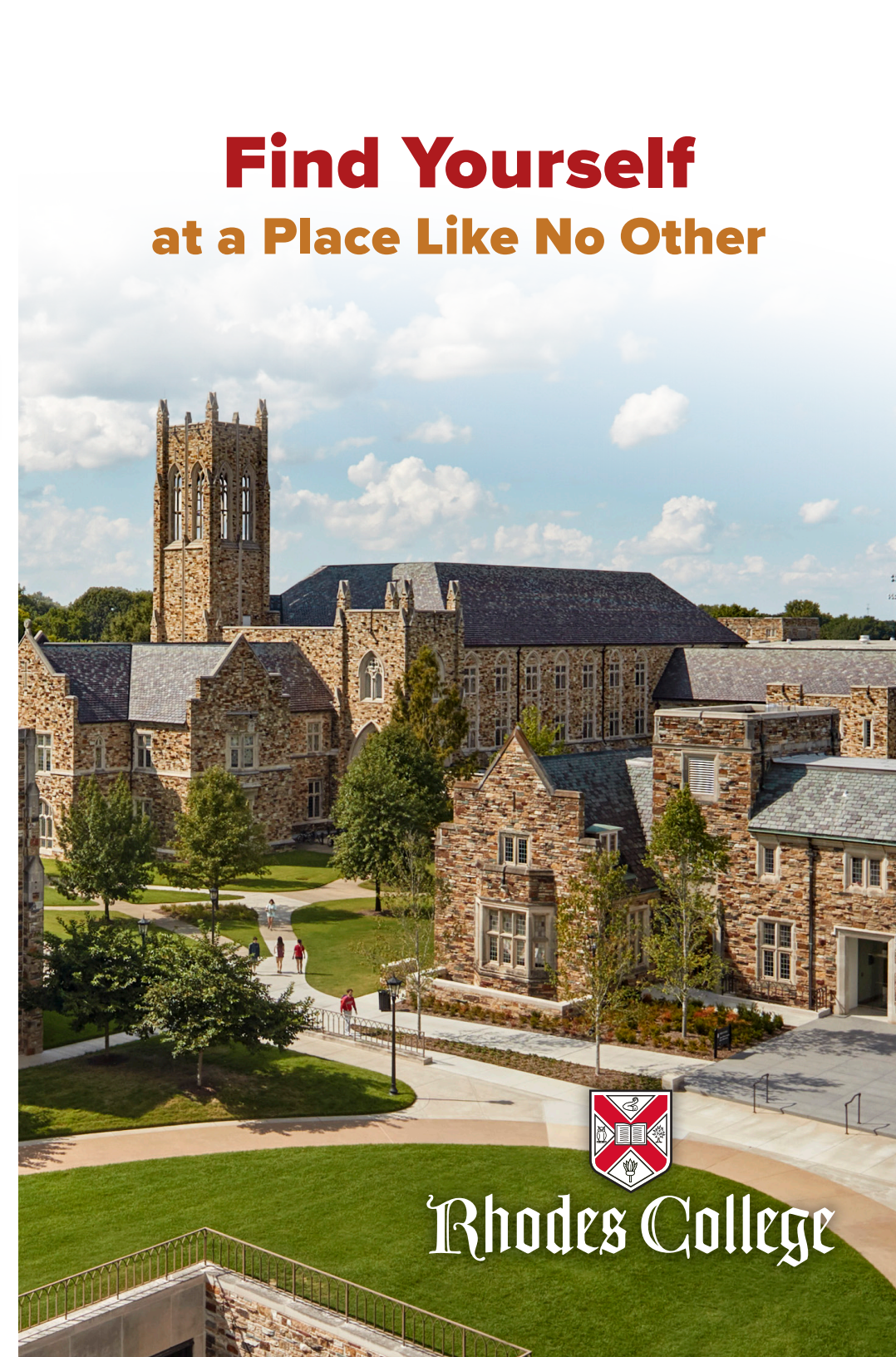
- Exchange Application
