4TH DISTRICT,

Comprehending those parts of the Parish of Old Machar which are situated to the South of the Denburn, and that part of the Parish of Banchory Devenick near the Bridge of Dee, comprehended within the Boundary of the Burgh, as fixed by the said Act of Parliament.

POLLING-PLACE,

AT OR NEAR THE CROSSING OF ROSE STREET AND THISTLE STREET, NORTHWARD FROM UNION PLACE.

5TH DISTRICT,

Comprehending those parts of the Parish of Old Machar which are situated between the Denburn, on the South, and the River Don, on the North.

POLLING-PLACE,

AT OR NEAR THE TOWN HOUSE OF OLD ABERDEEN.

N.B.—Electors will observe that, by the Act, it is provided, that every Voter shall Poll at the Polling-Place of the District within which the Premises in respect of which he claims to vote, may be situate.

** Where Voters claim on their Dwelling-house and Shop, Counting-house, or Warehouse, &c. jointly, they Poll at the Polling-place of the District in which their Dwellinghouse is situate.

There is NO fee or charge whatever exigible from Electors at Polling.
