FULL TIME ROUTE

Stage 1

- AT5029 Supervised Reading I (15 credit points)
- AT5032 Research in Social Anthropology 1 (Extended) (30 credit points)
- AT5033 Research Skills in Anthropology (15 credit points)

Stage 2

- AT5531 Research in Social Anthropology 2 (30 credit points)
- AT5532 Research Design and Practice in Anthropology (15 credit points)
- AT5906 Scottish Training in Anthropological Research (15 credit points)

Stage 3

- AT5910 Dissertation in Social Anthropology (60 credit points)

PART TIME ROUTE

This route will run over two years. Students can take up to 120 credit points in a single year. AT5910 must be taken in Year 2. The following courses are compulsory and can be taken in either Year 1 or Year 2:

- AT5029 Supervised Reading I (15 credit points)
- AT5032 Research in Social Anthropology 1 (Extended) (30 credit points)
- AT5033 Research Skills in Anthropology (15 credit points)
- AT5531 Research in Social Anthropology 2 (30 credit points)
- AT5532 Research Design and Practice in Anthropology (15 credit points)
- AT5906 Scottish Training in Anthropological Research (15 credit points)

Assessment: All assessment is based on course work with the exception of AT5906, which requires participation in a residential training course.
