This programme is undertaken by students studying under the University's articulation agreement with the University of Economics, Hochiminh City.

Duration: Students undertake 6 months study at the University of Economics between July and December (60 credits). From January onwards the students register at University of Aberdeen. 6 months study is undertaken face-to-face at the University of Aberdeen. The dissertation is completed at the University of Economics, and students remain registered at the University of Aberdeen during the course of it. The programme is studied on a full time basis.

Content: The content below applies only to the courses that students study through University of Aberdeen.

Assessment: By course work, by written examination or by a combination of those, as prescribed for each course. The degree of MSc (Econ) shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve CGS D3 in the relevant dissertation course, irrespective of their performance in other courses.
