TRANSITION TO THE NEW QAA QUALITY CODE

- 6.1 The Group heard from the Dean for Quality Assurance and Enhancement regarding the planned transition from the Quality Assurance Agency (QAA) 2018 Quality Code to the newly published 2024 Quality Code:
 - (i) The Group was informed that the new version of the QAA Quality Code provides greater granularity in terms of the 12 principles and contains a new section on data which will require further consideration.
 - (ii) The Group was advised that whilst this may present some challenges in terms of mapping there is an agreement across the sector that this transition will be gradual. Thus, work will continue to map the Quality Code, and the relevant updates, section by section as part of APRG rather than all at once.
