Duration: 12 months full-time, 24 months part-time or 36 months part-time (MSc);
9 months full-time, 21 months part-time, 30 months part-time (PgDip).

Content: Candidates undertake the following:

FULL TIME ROUTE

Stage 1

- LN5048 Language-Specific Translation Portfolio (30 credit points)
- LN5049 Key Concepts and Methods in translation studies (30 credit points)
- LN5050 Editing, Proofreading and Reviewing for Translators (15 credit points)

Stage 2

LN5048 Language-Specific Translation Portfolio (Continues into term two)

Plus 45 credit points from the following list:

- LN5551 Additional Language-specific Translation Portfolio (15 credit points)
- LN5552 Literary Translation (15 credit points)
- LN5553 Translation Technology (15 credit points)
- LN5554 Professional Skills for Translators (15 credit points)

Stage 3

LN5955 Dissertation/Translation Project in Translation Studies (MSc) (60 credit points)

PART TIME ROUTE

This route will run over two/three years. Students can take up to 120 credit points in a single year. LN5955 must be taken in Year 2 if the programme is taken over two years, or in Year 3 if the programme is taken over three years. The following courses are compulsory and can be taken in either Year 1 or Year 2:

- LN5048 Language-Specific Translation Portfolio (30 credit points)
- LN5049 Key Concepts and Methods in translation studies (30 credit points)
- LN5050 Editing, Proofreading and Reviewing for Translators (15 credit points)

Plus 45 credit points from the following list:

- LN5551 Additional Language-specific Translation Portfolio (15 credit points)
- LN5552 Literary Translation (15 credit points)
- LN5553 Translation Technology (15 credit points)
- LN5554 Professional Skills for Translators (15 credit points)

LN5955 Dissertation/Translation Project in Translation Studies (MSc) (60 credit points)

For Both Routes (full-time and part-time):

The degree of MSc shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve a grade of D3 or above in the Dissertation/Translation Project in Translation Studies and the Language-Specific Translation Portfolio, irrespective of their performance in other courses.

The courses below can be taken as standalone courses:

LN5050 Editing, Proofreading and Reviewing for Translators (15 credit points)

LN5049 Key Concepts and Methods in translation studies (30 credit points)

LN5522 Professional Skills for Translators (15 credit points)

LN5552 Literary Translation (15 credit points)

LN5553 Translation Technology (15 credit points)

Candidates taking LN5049 (30 credit points) can also take LN5048 Language-Specific Translation Portfolio (30 credit points). If an additional language is offered, LN5551 Additional Language-specific Translation Portfolio (15 credit points) can also be taken.

Candidates wanting to choose some of the courses offered as standalone courses obtain a PGCert on the courses completed.
