PART TIME ROUTE

This route will run over three years. Students take 4 courses of 30 Credits, not required in any sequence, plus the 60-credit dissertation, DR505X. Courses can be taken as 'stand alone' courses for professional development (CPD).

In addition, MTh students must complete:

DR505X Research Skills and Dissertation Writing (60 credit points)

Assessment: The taught courses will be assessed by a variety of means that may include poster presentations, journals and essays.

PGDip Assessment: Students must acquire 120 credit points Assessment is by course work, by written examination, or by a combination of these, as prescribed for each course.

PGCert Assessment: Students must acquire 60 credit points Assessment is by course work, by written examination, or by a combination of these, as prescribed for each course.
