2.	Candidates who have not passed PS 4019 but have enough other elements in the Grade Spectrum for the award of an Honours degree shall be awarded the non-accredited Behavioural Studies degree.
3.	Honours programme may only be taken by full-time study.
4.	Designated Programme: See Supplementary Regulation 1 Levels 1 and 2 as for Honours programme. Level 3 – a minimum of 90 credit points to include PS 3011, PS 3014, PS 3015, PS 3520, PS 3518, PS 3519, PS 3522.
5.	Candidates seeking entry to the Junior Honours programme must have accumulated, by award or recognition, or been exempted from, at least 240 credit points at levels 1 and 2, including those compulsory courses required to enter programme year 3.
