Stage 3

Students will be advised on the process for project allocation at registration. The research projects will be in the areas of Molecular and Cellular Immunology and Fungal Biology.

Assessment: By practical work, by written essays, written examinations, by oral presentations or by a combination of these as prescribed for each course. The thesis will be assessed and the student will undertake oral examination on completion of the programme.
