Stage 1

AY5008 Human Osteology (30 credit points)

AY5002* Theory and Method in Research (30 credit points)

Stage 2

AY5506 Ancient Health and Disease (30 credit points)

AY5504 Advanced Archaeology Approaches (30 credit points)

*Subject to agreement, the course can be replaced with other Archaeology courses or one from a sister discipline, such as Anthropology. (note, only a maximum of 30 credits can be taken in non-archaeology courses across Stages 1 and 2)

Stage 3

AY5905 Osteoarchaeology Dissertation (60 credit points)

Assessment: By coursework, by written examination, or by a combination of these, as prescribed for each course. Please see individual course entries in the *Postgraduate Catalogue of Courses*, or departmental documentation, for further details. The degree of MSc shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to complete the dissertation at CGS Grade of D3 or above, irrespective of their performance in other courses.
